1. General Provisions

This Cookie Policy (hereinafter – the Policy) sets out how UAB “Nordstreet”, company registration number 304565690, registered address A. Domaševičiaus g. 9, LT-01113 Vilnius, Lithuania (hereinafter – Nordstreet, the Company, we, us), uses cookies and similar technologies on the website www.nordstreet.com (hereinafter – the Website).

Nordstreet respects the privacy of Website visitors and is committed to maintaining the highest standards of personal data protection. This Policy explains which cookies are used, for what purposes, on what legal basis data is processed, and how visitors can manage their preferences.

This Policy applies to all Website visitors and should be read together with the Nordstreet Privacy Policy.

2. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device when you visit the Website.

Cookies and similar technologies enable us to:

- ensure the proper functioning of the Website;
- maintain user sessions;
- remember user preferences and settings;
- protect the Website against misuse and automated attacks;
- analyse Website usage;
- improve user experience;
- evaluate the effectiveness of marketing activities.

In this Policy, the term “cookies” also covers similar technologies such as local storage, pixels, tags, and other identifiers.

3. Legal Basis

Cookies are used in accordance with:

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council (GDPR);
- the Law on Electronic Communications of the Republic of Lithuania;
- other applicable European Union and Lithuanian legislation.

Strictly necessary cookies are placed automatically, as they are required for the Website to function.

Non-essential cookies are only placed upon obtaining the visitor’s consent, except where otherwise permitted by law.

4. Google Consent Mode

Nordstreet uses Google Consent Mode technology, which ensures that Google Analytics and other Google services are activated in accordance with the visitor’s selected consent preferences.

This technology helps ensure greater transparency, enhanced privacy protection, and compliance with European Union data protection requirements.

5. Cookie Categories

5.1. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the Website to function and cannot be disabled. They are used for:

- user authentication;
- session management;
- security purposes;

- protection against fraud and automated requests;
- storing cookie consent preferences.

5.2. Functional Cookies

These cookies allow the Website to remember user choices and provide an enhanced browsing experience.

5.3. Statistical Cookies

These cookies are used to collect information about how the Website is used and help us:

- understand visitor behaviour;
- identify technical issues;
- improve Website performance;
- optimise content.

5.4. Marketing Cookies

These cookies are used to measure the effectiveness of marketing activities and to understand how visitors reach the Website.

8. International Transfers of Personal Data

Some service providers used by Nordstreet may process data outside the European Economic Area, including in the United States of America.

In such cases, Nordstreet ensures that data transfers are carried out with appropriate safeguards in place, including:

- European Commission adequacy decisions;
- the EU–U.S. Data Privacy Framework, where applicable;
- Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) approved by the European Commission;
- other transfer mechanisms permitted under the GDPR.

9. Consent Management

Visitors may:

- accept all cookies;
- reject all non-essential cookies;
- select specific cookie categories;
- change their preferences at any time.

Consent may be withdrawn at any time using the cookie management tool available on the Website.

Nordstreet retains records of cookie consents for as long as necessary to fulfil legal obligations, ensure compliance, and defend against potential legal claims.

10. Cookie Audit

Nordstreet conducts an audit of cookies and other tracking technologies at least once every 12 months.

Additional reviews may be carried out following significant technical or functional changes to the Website.

The list of cookies and their retention periods may be updated periodically.

11. Your Rights

Where cookies involve the processing of personal data, you have the right to:

- access your personal data;
- request rectification of inaccurate data;
- request erasure of your data;
- restrict the processing of your data;

- object to the processing of your data;
- lodge a complaint with the State Data Protection Inspectorate (www.vdai.lrv.lt).

12. Minors

The Website is not directed at persons under the age of 16. Nordstreet does not knowingly collect personal data from individuals under 16 years of age.


If we become aware that personal data has been collected from a minor without verified parental or guardian consent, we will delete such data without undue delay.

- Choose your preferred cookie control level or add exceptions for specific websites

Mozilla Firefox

- Open the ☰ menu → Settings
- Select “Privacy & Security”
- Under “Cookies and Site Data”, choose your protection level or click “Manage Data”

Apple Safari

- Open “Preferences” (or “Settings” on iOS) → “Privacy”
- Under “Cookies and website data”, select “Block all cookies” or your preferred option
- Click “Manage Website Data” to view or delete cookies from specific websites

Microsoft Edge

- Open the ... menu → Settings
- Select “Cookies and site permissions” → “Cookies and site data”

- Manage cookie blocking or allow specific websites

Please note: disabling or deleting cookies may cause certain Website features to function incorrectly or become unavailable.
Changes to browser cookie settings may also affect other websites you visit.
